


Over the last year at Dismas House, programming dramatically expanded to support our community of returning citizens. Through our Four Pillars of Programming -Basic Needs, Health & Well-Being, Life Skills, and Legal Support - we were able to offer wraparound care for our residents on their journeys to reentry.

We waived term limits for how long a resident can stay at Dismas House which makes our campus a solution for combatting housing issues that plague all returning citizens.

We also added a Clinical Director and a Certified Peer Recovery Specialist (CPRS) to our team, strengthening our recovery and relapse prevention programming which has been instrumental in us reducing recidivism numbers.

rates of return for our new Dismas House campus graduates. Our inaugural one year rate of return is 5.6% compared to state's rate of 26%. The goal for the two year rate of return is 8%, which is significantly lower that the state's rate of 39%.


